

**DISPOSAL FROM THE  
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE  
TO  
HOMER BEECHER**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

THAT, The State of New Hampshire, by John A. Clements, Commissioner of Public Works and Highways, pursuant to vote of the Governor and Council on December 21, 1983, and in accordance with the provisions of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapter 228:31, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred fifty (\$550.00) dollars, to it in hand before the delivery hereof, well and truly paid by Homer Beecher of 112 Main Street, Colebrook, County of Coos, The State of New Hampshire has remised, released, and forever Quitclaimed, and by these presents does remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Homer Beecher, to the survivor of him and the heirs of the survivor of him, his heirs and assigns forever:

Any and all interest the State of New Hampshire has in a strip of land measuring twelve and twenty-five hundredths (12.25') feet by one hundred thirty-five and fifty hundredths (133.50') feet and containing one thousand, six hundred thirty-five (1,635) square feet, more or less, and being Easterly of and adjacent to other land of the Grantee, said strip being a portion of the Beecher Falls Railroad right-of-way and lying Easterly twenty and seventy-five hundredths (20.75') feet of the Center Line of the main track in the Town of Colebrook, County of Coos, State of New Hampshire.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Grantees, to them and their heirs and assigns forever.
