This morning, CORD, under the direction of it's attorney, Allen Brooks, endorsed the use of ATVs on the "Kelsey Notch Connection" and "Kelsey Notch Road" trail corridors at Nash Stream Forest. Attorney Brooks made it clear that no vote by CORD was necessary, or appropriate, under RSA 162-C:6. The presentation went smoothly..Clint, Harry Brown and Craig Washburn handled all of CORD's concerns. The next step is to execute a 3-year pilot agreement with the local ATV club - Metallak ATV Club, assuring that all environmental and safety concerns are addressed.
