Dear CORD Members,

Our club maintains trails in the Stark and Milan area as well as in Success and Cambridge. In March of 2022, Dummer residents voted to close their town roads to ATV traffic. Until we are able to open up a new off-road connector trail, this means there is no way for ATV's to travel east from Stark.

The only route available for Stark riders is to travel west to Groveton then north through Stratford and then through Kelsey Notch to access riding in Colebrook/Pittsburg or Millsfield. From Millsfield they can continue south to Success or Milan.

We respectfully request that members of the CORD committee continue to keep the trails in Kelsey Notch open since they are the only alternative left for riders in the Stark area to access these other trail systems.
