Commissioner Stewart has forwarded your inquiry to me for response. This is to confirm that the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (DNCR) received your comments related to the Landowner Policy program and the Commercial General Liability policy. We appreciate your interest and suggestions related to this program, and will take your comments into consideration.

We treat your inquiry as a request for public records under RSA 91-A. The term “public record” refers to specific pre-existing files, documents or data in an agency’s files, and not to information which might be gathered or compiled from numerous sources. *Brent v. The DNCR does not have public records specific to your inquiries.
